



2017 Rules & Regulations

Fair Dates: August 30 – September 4, 2017

- **Payment in full is due May 1, 2017 for the 2017 Fair season.** A late payment of \$50 will be charged for past due payments. Payment in full will help ensure an easier check-in during fair week. Returned check fee is \$50.
- **Only products listed on your vendor application and approved by the Fair Board may be sold.**
- **Soft drinks and bottled water may only be purchased from the Pepsi Distributor on the Fairgrounds. To arrange deliveries, contact Chuck Destephano at (724) 512-2119.**
- **Contracts do not allow subletting of space nor are they transferable.**
- Unless indicating on your contract that you would like to purchase insurance through the Fair, all concessionaires must present Proof of Insurance listing the Great Stoneboro Fair as Additionally Insured before August 1, 2017.
- Concessions must be set up by 3pm on Wednesday, August 30th. Tear down time will begin at 10pm Monday, September 4, 2017. All concessions must be off the fairgrounds by Wednesday, September 6th, 2017 unless prior arrangements have been made. All materials you bring onto the fairgrounds must be taken with you.
- Concessions must be kept clean and presentable at all times and trash put in proper containers. Do not put large cardboard boxes in trash cans, set them beside the trash cans. All cooking oil must be disposed of in provided barrels.
- Any materials the fair board deems obscene, dangerous, unlawful or otherwise inappropriate for a family friendly environment is strictly prohibited from sales, promotion and display or advertised in any way.
- Merchandise, food, or other materials being sold, promoted, displayed, given away, or marketed shall be conducted within the designated space rented by the vendor.
- Vehicles may not operate on fair property after 8am until closing each night. Please have your vehicle parked by 8am. Concessions must be open during the hours of the fair. Any concession that leaves early will not be allowed to return the following year unless approval has been given for a special circumstance by the fair board.
- Posting of signs or self-adhering stickers will not be permitted outside of vendor's rented space.
- All merchandise belonging to anyone will be the sole responsibility of the owner. The Great Stoneboro Fair will not be responsible for any loss by theft, accident, or act of God.
- All CO2 and propane cylinders in food concessions and commercial exhibits are required to be secured and labels visible.
- There are no plug-in receptacles available in vendor areas. All connections are hard-wired to breaker panels. Electricians are available for hook ups 9am to 8pm Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday prior to the Fair. Disconnects are available the evening of Fair closing and the following two days from 7am to 3pm. There will be an upgrade fee of \$50 to upgrade the breaker size after the initial installation plus the increase in breaker cost. This upgrade will be automatic after the third reset of a tripped breaker. Upgrade fees and expenses must be paid in cash at the Office prior to the work being completed.
